The Foster Kidd Foundation *Board of Directors* may approve financial support to any organization or individual whose purpose in requesting such support is consistent with the Foundation's objective of aiding the development of youth through academic and practical educational experiences. The Board may also approve grants and scholarships to youth for purposes of assisting them in their academic education or progression in the game golf. Individuals may be asked to show proof of financial need in order to be considered for an award.

### FOUNDATION MISSION STATEMENT

The Mission is to support the enhancement & development of the Pro-Duffers Golf Club – Southwest Chapter's Junior Golf Program & other non-profit youth oriented programs and agencies in the North Texas area with similar ideals as deemed necessary.

### SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

#### Eligibility

1. Individuals below the age of 19 years may be eligible for financial assistance for any educational endeavor approved by the board. Such applicants must demonstrate an ongoing association with the game of golf through individual play, instruction, or other associations as approved by the Foundation Board of Directors.
2. Individuals above the age of 19 years – but less than 23 years- may apply for financial assistance related to their continuing enrollment in an accredited college or university in pursuit of an academic degree.

#### Application Process

1. Applications will be by letter (or other appropriate written form) addressed to The Foundation or any member of the Board of Directors.
2. Applications may be submitted at any time and will be considered by the Board at its first meeting following receipt of the written request. All requests will be answered in writing. Please allow at least 30 days for responses for all request.
3. Scholarships may be approved by a majority vote of the Board members based on financial need.

#### Limitations

1. Maximum scholarship assistance will be limited to \$2000 per individual per academic year.
2. Once awarded, academic scholarships may be renewed by the Board on an annual basis for no more than a total of four consecutive awards (years). Renewal applicants must be in good standing with their respective educational institution and provide evidence of a grade point average equivalent to at least 2.0 (on a 4-point GPA scale).

### GRANT CRITERIA

#### Eligibility

The Foundation Board may award grants to any individual or organization for any purpose consistent with the objectives of the Foundation. Scholarship recipients may also be awarded supplemental grants for purposes that are approved by the Board.
